

Singapore Children's Society Photo Contest Terms and Conditions

1. By entering into the Singapore Children's Society Photo Contest (known herein as the Contest, all Contest's digital platform pages known herein as the Page, Singapore Children's Society known herein as the Organiser), you acknowledge and agree to all the Terms and Conditions as set out herein.
2. This Contest is open to Singapore citizens and residents of Singapore (known herein as the Contestant). Contestants who are below 12 years of age must submit proof of parental or guardian consent for their participation in this Contest, when required by the Organiser.
3. The Contest starts on 1 August 2016 and will end on 31 August 2016 (known herein as the Contest Period). Closing dateline for submission is 2359 Singapore time of 31 August 2016.
4. Photographs submitted must be the Contestant's own work and must be taken in Singapore. Photos that have won prizes in other photography competitions, or have been previously used or are intended to be used for any kind of commercial purposes, must not be submitted.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to remove submissions that:
 - a. are libellous, profane, defamatory, disparaging, hateful, harassing, threatening, racially or religiously biased or offensive, or obscene;
 - b. violate another's copyright or intellectual property rights;
 - c. condone or promote illegal activity;
 - d. are fraudulent, deceptive or misleading;
 - e. are otherwise sexual or offensive graphically or in tone;
 - f. contain spam or are intended to cause technical disruptions to this Page;
 - g. are posted on behalf of any merchant or manufacturer, or the Contestants were compensated or granted any consideration by any third party;
 - h. are off topic; or
 - i. violate any law or regulation.
6. Anyone repeatedly posting material that falls into the above categories will be removed and/or banned from participating on this Page.
7. The Organiser reserves the right to use any other method or medium at its sole and absolute discretion for the purpose of announcing the winners of the Contest (known herein as the Contest Winners).
8. The Organiser reserves the right to appoint a third party to conduct the verification of Contest Winners.
9. The immediate family members of employees and the organising committee members of Singapore Children's Society (including children, parents, brothers, sisters and spouses) are not eligible to participate in the Contest.
10. The Organiser reserves the right to amend the Contest Period at any time without prior notice. All entries received after the Contest Period shall automatically be disqualified.
11. You are strictly not allowed to modify, report, re-produce or use the contents of Singapore Children's Society Facebook Page for public or commercial purposes without a written permission from the Organiser. This includes the text, image, audio and video content.

12. The Organiser does not endorse any opinions on the Page not specifically posted by the Organiser.
13. The Organiser is not responsible for the accuracy of any claims, information, advice or comments not posted by its official account.
14. By entering this Contest, you agree that, if your entry is a prize winning entry, you grant the Organiser the royalty free, non-exclusive right to reproduce it for any purpose at any time in any media with attribution. You warrant to the Organiser that your entries do not infringe the intellectual property rights of any person.
15. The Organiser may reject any submission at its sole and absolute discretion without having to assign any reason whatsoever.
16. The Organiser may request a valid identification of NRIC number/passport number of any Contest Winner before the prize is awarded. The Organiser reserves the right to forfeit any prizes for any Contest Winner who does not provide the required documents upon the request of the Organiser or upon the prize collection.
17. Judges' decisions are final and binding. No queries, challenges, appeal or correspondence will be entertained. All judging rights to the voted photo submissions are reserved and are at the judges' discretion.
18. Contestants shall indemnify and hold the Organiser and its employees and agents harmless against any and all claims in relation to the participation of this Contest and breach of the Terms and Conditions contained herein.
19. The Organiser will not be responsible or liable for:
 - a. Any problem, loss or damage of whatsoever nature suffered by any party due to any delay and/or failure in storing the photo entry as a result of any network, communication or system error, interruption and/or any delay or failure in the internet line and/or any delay or failure in the participation or the downloading of any materials in the Contest. In the event of such error, interruption and/or failure, the Organiser shall not be responsible or liable for any failure by any Contestant to participate in the Contest at any time.
 - b. Any problem, damage or loss of whatsoever nature to any Contestant, or their representatives resulting from their participation in the Contest, and/or access to the Page.
 - c. Any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, internet line delay or failure, theft, destruction of, or unauthorised access to entries, arising during operation or transmission as a result of any server function, virus, bug or other cause outside its control.

Contestants must also agree that the Organiser shall not be responsible nor liable for any delay, injury or damage to the Contestant's and/or any third party's property, computer, computer system or apparatus relating to or resulting from the access to the Page and/or the participation in this Contest, including the playing, downloading of any material or information from the Page and submission for this Contest, including without limitation to any server failure, lost, delayed or corrupted data or other malfunction.
21. The Organiser may at its sole discretion disqualify any individual that it determines to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest, or to be acting in breach or potential breach of this Contest's Terms and Conditions.

The Organiser has the right to use the names, photographs, videos and/or other submission materials of the Contestants and all other entries for advocacy, fundraising and/or publicity purposes without any prior notice to you. The Contestants shall not be entitled to claim ownership or other forms of compensation on the materials.
24. The Organiser reserves the right to change, amend, delete or add to these Terms and Conditions without prior notice at any time and the Contestants shall be bound to such changes.
25. By providing the personal information upon the submission of entries, the Contestants consent and are agreeable to the usage of their personal information by the Organiser, including but not limited to names, images and photographs.
26. In respect of any third party's personal information as disclosed by any Contestant in his/her submissions to the Organiser, the Contestant hereby warrants that he/she has the right to do so and he/she has obtained the consent from such third party to disclose such personal information. Contestants shall be responsible for ensuring that such disclosures are in compliance with the provisions of Singapore Personal Data Protection Act 2012.
27. Contestants may notify the Organiser of any updates, amendments and corrections to previously collected information by using the Facebook Message on the Singapore Children's Society Facebook page.
28. All images must be in JPEG format and with minimal compression (approximately 5 Megapixel resolution or file sizes of maximum 2MB size). Digital manipulation that distorts the reality of the photographs is not allowed. Only basic and minimal enhancements, such as sharpening, contrast adjustment, converting colour images to black and white, are allowed.
29. Prize(s) are not transferrable or exchangeable and must be accepted as provided.
30. The Organiser reserves the right to change, add or substitute the prizes.
31. The Organiser is not an agent of any merchant. Any dispute about the quality, merchantability and fitness for purpose of the prize must be resolved directly with the merchant.
